### ● The 6th Whitstable Biennale Whitstable

These days it seems no seaside town on the south-east coast is without a gallery or art festival. Whitstable got in there early and its biennale has been going strong since 2000. Alternative community get-togethers are the theme of this latest instalment, which sees artists stage performances in such diverse locations as boats out at sea and the town's indoor bowling alley. Highlights include Jesse Jones exploring radical group therapy methods of the 1960s and Emma Hart's spin on role-playing games, with an installation



featuring puppets made from wing-mirrors and wooden cocktails. An artist's film programme exploring dance and possession includes Maya Deren's voodoo-infused work (pictured) and Joachim Koester's

terrific Tarantism. If you fancy jumping around a bit yourself, Jeremy Deller's Stonehenge bouncy castle is also making a welcome guest appearance. ss
